*In the Roman time known as Mare Superum, the Adriatic Sea was a closed pool in the Mediterranean which contained over 1200 islands from which most are located on the eastern coastlines, on the Croatian part of Adriatic Sea. The closeness, the sea currents and positions of the islands made the Adriatic sea a perfect destination for sailing and recreation on the sea.*

*Although not totally without peril, the Adriatic Sea can not be compared with the rest of the Mediterranean Sea and has far from the same ocean conditions. This has been made possible by the development of nautical tourism and nautical infrastructure in Croatia, which today stands together with Italian, Spanish and French.*

*Villages and towns are situated on 56 islands which are inhabited on the Croatian Adriatic. This means guests are able to visit over 1000 uninhabited islands to which you can only arrive by a boat. This fact opens up numerous possibilities for offers of different activities and recreation which we want to present to you. Be that a sport, recreation or a search for a gastronomic delicacies, cultural and historical sight-seeing or just simple experience, you can adjust your summer experience to your wishes.*

## **About**

*Croatia is a small Mediterranean country, which has all its coast spread across the Adriatic sea. It borders with Italy by sea and with Slovenia, Serbia, Bosnia and Herzegovina and Montenegro by lands. It is a country with rapturous history and rich cultural heritage. Its capital is Zagreb, which represents economical, cultural and political centre of the country, while the larger city's on the coast like Rijeka, Split, Pula, Zadar and Dubrovnik represent main destinations and centers of tourism.*

## **Climate**

*Costal area of Croatia has the mediterranean climate with temperatures during winter from 6 to 11°C, and during summer from 21 to 27°C. With approximately 2.600 sunshine hours during the year the Adriatic coast has one of the sunniest climats in Mediterranean.*

*Best time for visiting Croatia*

*Best time to visit Croatia is between April and October. The high season (July and August) offers more entertainment for guest that search for fun and excitement, but diversity of the Croatian coast gives a variety of opportunities for finding the quiet corners and peaceful oasis for guests who look for natural beauties far away from the city rushes.*

## **The language and communication**

*Official language is Croatian, but as the Croatia is a tourist country, the majority of the population speaks English, German and Italian language.*

## **Currency**

*Croatian currency is Kuna. 1 kuna (HRK) is divided into 100 lipa.*

*Standard credit cards - Eurocard/Mastercard, Diners, American Express and Visa, are common way of payment in Croatia.*

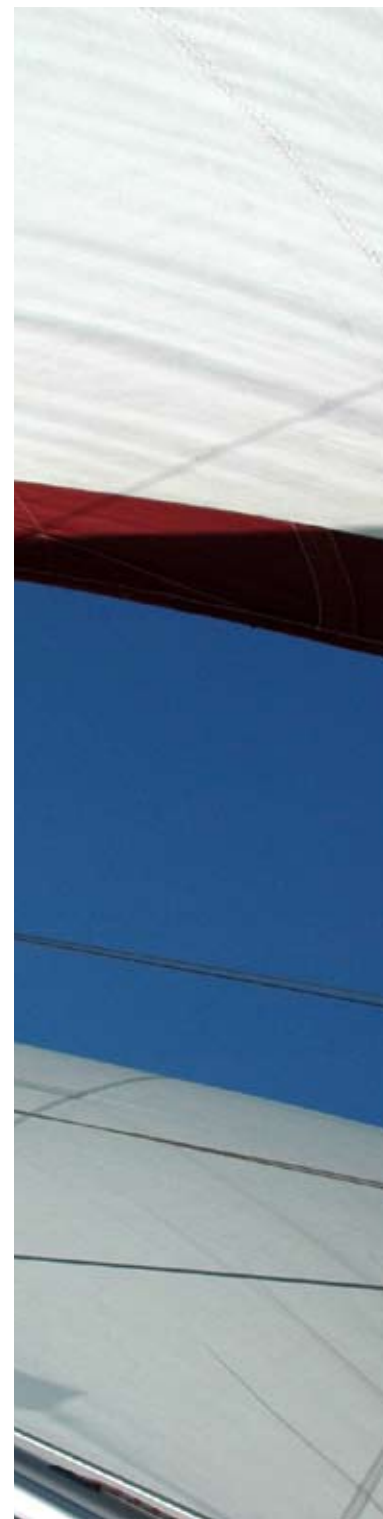
### **Full board**

## The Northern Adriatic

## **The Central Adriatic**

*This region is the well of Croatia's natural beauty which is held across two national parks, Kornati and Krka as well as across countless islands and isles of the Zadar and Šibenik archipelago. This area is abundant with quality fish, excellent restaurants which lie along the shores and an unrivalled landscape. People are extremely friendly, and the many islands give shelter to the land from the open sea, and as such giving an excellent terrain for all kinds of sporting events upon the sea.*

*The islands of the central Adriatic also offer many extraordinary locations for hosting a variety of events in the rustic ambience of „the Mediterranean as it once was“. Also, you are able to combine sailing on the gentle sea with hiking through the rugged rocky hills in the national park of Pakenica or on the cliffs of the natural park of Telašćica.*

*Visit Zadar and Šibenik, Biograd, Primošten and Rogoznica, costal towns which are filled with the Mediterranean architecture and culture that was forged through centuries.*

*Visit the Zlarin coral reefs and sea-sponge harvesters of Krapanj, see the way of life and work of the people and discover how these materials are turned into jewellery. Give a gift to your dearest, a souvenir which they will treasure forever.*





## **The Southern Adriatic**

---

*This region is steeped in the culture, tradition and magnificent islands and coastal villages of southern and central Dalmatia. These are a chain of islands, which over the centuries developed an architectural personality and very special culture. Also, this region offers a perfect opportunity for sampling the endemic gastronomic delicacies which surround you on all sides. The influences of tourism have renewed and saved from being lost a variety of traditional recipes which will delight you.*

*In this region are situated a number of larger islands: Brač, Šolta, Hvar, Vis, Korčula, Lastovo and Mljet, from which each developed a different culture, dialect and gastronomy. All the islands are surrounded with smaller isles that will enable you to escape from other sailors. Because of size, these islands represented a good spot for development of towns which will delight you with their position, tradition, the architecture but also with a wide offer of entertainment and shopping.*

*Visit Korčula, the town where by legend Marco Polo was born. Visit Vis, island which was a military base until the beginning of 90's of the last century. This enabled it to become one of the most preserved and most impressive islands on the Adriatic.*

*Visit town of Hvar, above which during the 17th century Napoleon built a fort from which you can enjoy an amazing view of the Pakleni islands.*

*Under sails visit the islands of the Dubrovnik archipelago and learn about the features of this area and then enjoy the entertainment of Dubrovnik night clubs or party by your own arrangement. The choices are limitless.*
